Note: The entrance door is on a timer, and is automatically locked after 7pm each night. The President and Vice president each have a security key; you will need one if you are needing to 'open up' after 7pm. The centre can be locked without one of the Club's security keys (as this is done from a control panel inside).

To lock up: Ensure the areas used by the Club are clean and tidy, and any dishes etc put away.

- Check the toilets - and turn off lights.
- Turn off lights and air-conditioning in the centre.
- The security control panel is in the broom cupboard. Gently turn the key a quarter turn as marked. This locks **one** set of the air-lock doors (the inside ones).
- To exit - press the green exit button to the right of the doors. Once the doors have closed behind you - check they are locked.

Lions Shed: Located at Spring Creek reserve, next to the Tennis Club and shared with Torquay Rotary Club. The combination for door lock is 1056.

Lions Club Ford Territory Vehicle: Kept at Lions Village. The key is kept in key safe near the kitchen door. The combination for door lock is 1056.
